Discussion:

- Collective Impact Update:
 - Some members of the BAHAH Committee have done some preliminary collective impact workshops with Innoweave
 - A proposal was submitted to Innoweave to receive a coaching grant for further collective impact work
 - **The proposal was approved** and we will await direction for next steps from Innoweave to move forward
 - A collective impact coach will be assigned to our group
- 'Us vs Them' documentary
 - A documentary filmed over 10 years follows 4 individuals in vulnerable circumstances
 - The Capitol Theatre is willing to arrange a screening – cost is \$500
 - The Friendship Centre offered to cover the cost of the \$500
 - It was recommended that Liana Clinton follow up with the filmmaker re: honorarium and travel expenses

- Community Housing Workshop
 - As per the directive set forth in the Community Housing Strategy, the BAHAH Committee will develop a community housing workshop
 - The recommended focus is 'developing partnerships', however, the committee may look at focusing on other aspects that may fit in with the collective impact work that is taking place (I.e. Advocacy and Barrier Removal)
 - CMHC may be able to supply some funding for the workshop

- Point in Time Count date
 - March 13th has been scheduled as the next date for a PiT Count
 - Liana Clinton has met with Harvey Thomas, Housing Manager for BATC, to discuss the possibility of doing a Point in Time Count on surrounding reserves
 - Library and schools could potentially be approached to participate in the count
